The CAZ Service Retreat is for small groups from churches, camp friends, or individuals to spend a weekend at camp in community working on various building, maintenance, or site enhancement projects at Camp Cazadero.



All camp participants would have meals together, free time, swim time & worship time. Work projects would be scheduled for a morning session and an afternoon session. Small groups can have time and space to meet in the evening or other times to be arranged.



For small church groups (i.e. Men's Fellowship, Youth Ministry Teams, Sunday school teachers) the CAZ Service retreat could act as a "mini-mission trip" where groups could have focused time working together on a project, and also separate time to meet as a group for program planning, training, or group bonding.

For other folks who want to give back something to the camping program, this retreat would be about connecting with other camp folks, doing work together, spending time in worship and fun time.
